1. Diploma/Degree Certificate in Homoeopathy (recognized by Central Council of Homoeopathy) original certificate will be returned after verification at the time of registration.
2. Mark sheets of Ist to final year Diploma/Degree qualification.
3. Internship completion certificate.
4. Date of birth certificate (High School or Sr. Secondary School).
5. All attested photocopies of Certificates should be signed by the applicant.
6. Three passport size photo-graph (one attested).
7. Registration fee Rs. 4,000/- & Form 'C' Rs. 200/-
8. Delhi proof of residence :-
(a)Pass Port (b)Voter I-Card (c)Ration Card (d)Driving License etc.

As per provision of Section – 24 Delhi Homoeopathic Act, 1956 & new Sub – Section – 5 of Delhi Homoeopathic Amendment Act, 1996 (Delhi Act No. 11 of 1996) the following formalities are also required to be completed:-

“Any person who makes an application for entry of his name in the register under sub – section (1) shall be required to submit an affidavit to the effect that he has not applied for registration in any other State or Union Territory and that if his name was registered with any other State or Union Territory at any time, he shall also submit a certificate of cancellation issued by the Board of any other competent authority of that State or Union Territory, as the case may be along with his affidavit”.

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
